





Delivery of Medical Benefits

Just over 1 million beneficiaries receive their full medical coverage from Medicaid (excludes duals, partial duals, family planning-only and alien emergency medical.)








County enrollment in managed care is voluntary.


Medicaid Expansion Goals

- Capitalize on opportunities to streamline administrative processes
- Leverage new federal financing opportunities to ensure the Medicaid expansion is sustainable
- Maximize use of technology to create consumer-friendly application/enrollment/renewal experience
- Maximize continuity of coverage & care as individuals move between subsidized coverage options
- Reform the Washington Way --- comply with, or seek waiver from, specific ACA requirements related to coverage and eligibility, as needs are identified

2014 ACA Continuum of “Insurance Affordability Programs”




Pre-Implementation of the ACA: Primary Source of Insurance in Washington State, 2011





Access to Care - Medicaid Considerations

- ↑ Primary care physician rate increase experiment – ~73% increases to encourage greater Medicaid participation from 2013 - 2014
 - Applies to fee-for-service and managed care: family physicians, pediatricians, internists
 - What happens post-2014 depends on results

- ↑ Insurance Commissioner health plan network assessment includes essential community providers in Qualified Health Plans
- Continuity of care option through Apple Health coverage when family circumstances split members across Medicaid/CHIP/ Exchange
- HPSA (health care professional shortage areas) concerns remain
- ↑ State Innovation Model grant opportunity suggests need to develop:
 - *“Innovations to improve the effectiveness, efficiency and appropriate mix of the health care work force...”*
