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SUBJECT LINE: Request for Proposals (RFP) Regarding Technical Assistance for Pilot and Design Grantees

Dear Feedback Network Member,

Today, the Healthier Washington team has released a Request for Proposals (RFP) regarding technical assistance (TA) for Pilot and Design grantees of Accountable Community of Health (ACH) planning funds. The intent of the TA is to assist in creating a strong organizational foundation. Six specific areas of TA are identified in the RFP:

1. Organizational infrastructure development
2. Sustainability planning
3. Stakeholder engagement and cascading engagement strategies
4. Change management and collective impact methodologies
5. Regional needs and resource inventory development
6. Health priorities development

It is the preference of Healthier Washington to contract with a single bidder, but the right has been reserved to contract with multiple bidders to best meet the needs of the communities and the State. A mandatory Letter of Intent is due February 26, 2015 and the proposal deadline is March 16, 2015.
