Subject: Reproductive Health Services, Family Planning Only Services, and TAKE CHARGE Services: Fee Schedule Updates

Effective for dates of service on and after July 1, 2011, the Health Care Authority (the Agency) will update the following fee schedules:

- The *Family Planning Fee Schedule* with the updated Medicare Physician Fee Schedule Data Base (MPFSDB) Year 2011 Relative Value Units (RVUs) and clinical laboratory fees; and
- The *Injectable Drug Fee Schedule*.

Overview

All previously published policies remain the same unless specifically identified as changed in this memo.

Fee Schedule Updates

For dates of service on and after July 1, 2011, the Agency will update the *Family Planning Fee Schedule* with the updated MPFSDB Year 2011 RVUs and the clinical laboratory fees. The Agency will adjust the maximum allowable fees to reflect these updates.
